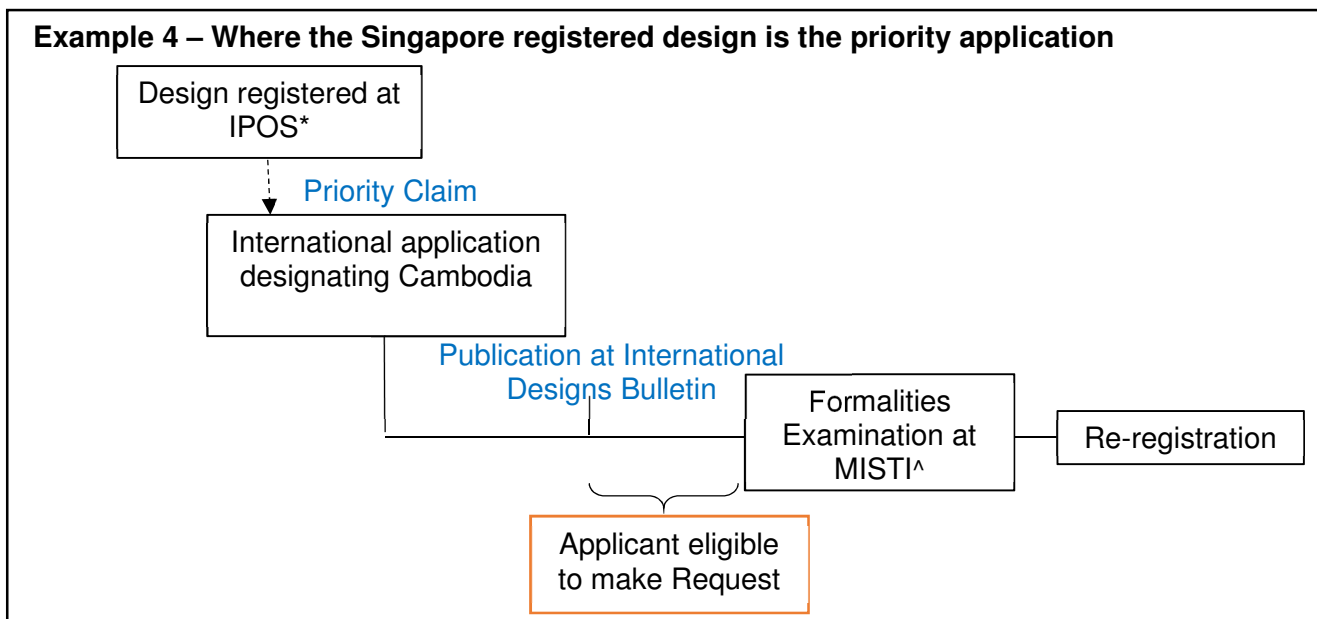
### Example 3 - Where the Cambodian registered design is the priority application

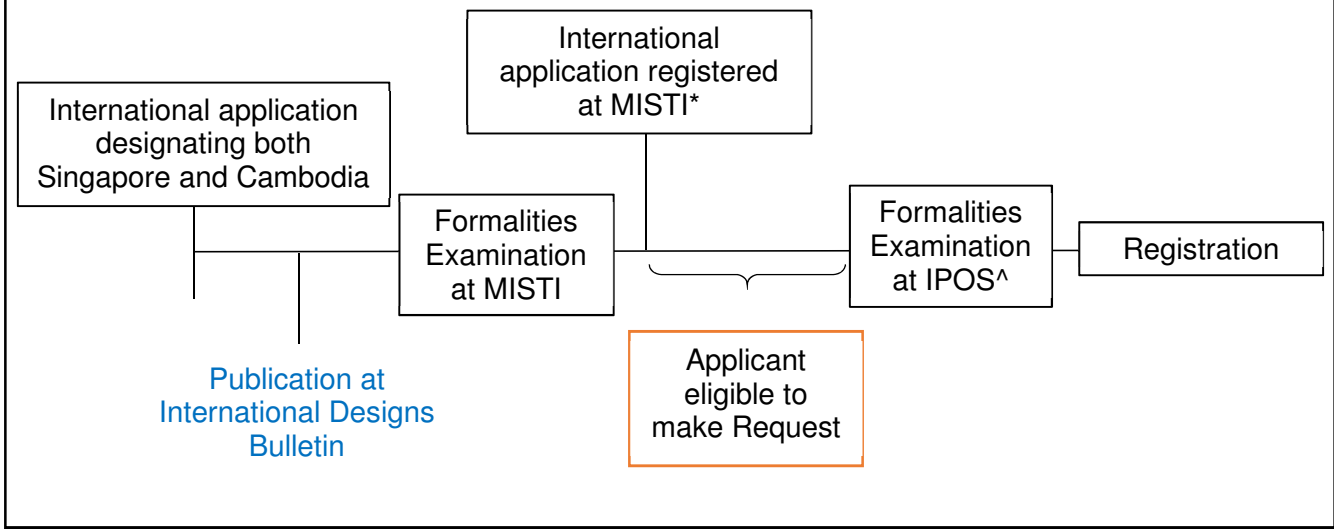
### Example 4 – Where the Singapore registered design is the priority application

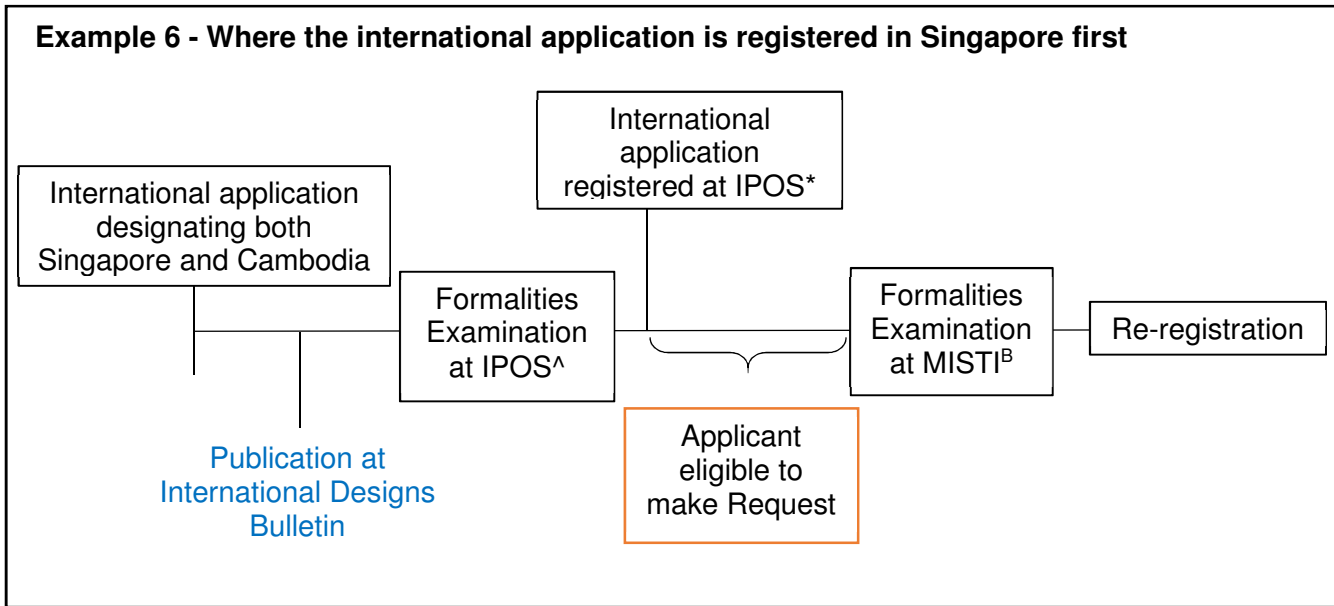
**Example 5 - Where the International application is registered in Cambodia first**
