Amendments to the Patents (Patent Agents) Rules to be brought into Force on 1 May 2017 [Circular No. 1/2017, dated 7 April 2017]

Please be informed that amendments to the Patents (Patent Agents) Rules 2001 will be brought into force on 1 May 2017.

New approved courses for patent agent qualification

- A new post-graduate course offered by the School of Business at the Singapore University of Social Sciences¹ IP and Innovation Management (specialisation in patent agency) will be recognised as an approved course for the registration as patent agent.
- 3 Effective from 1 May 2017, individuals who graduate with <u>any one</u> of the following credentials, shall be recognised as fulfilling the training requirements for the registration as patent agent:
 - Graduate Diploma in IP and Innovation Management (specialisation in patent agency) by the Singapore University of Social Sciences (new)
 - Master of IP and Innovation Management (specialisation in patent agency) by Singapore University of Social Sciences (new)
 - Graduate Certificate in Intellectual Property Law by the National University of Singapore

Patent agent registration requirements for examiners

- 4 Effective from 1 May 2017, individuals who wish to register as a patent agent based on his/her work as an Examiner in Singapore, must fulfill the following requirements:
 - a) At least seven years' of experience in search and examination work in Singapore;
 - b) Good performance record;
 - c) Completed courses for papers A and C;
 - d) Passed QE papers A and C.
