- vii. Photographs must be clearly labelled with the Applicant's name, Contact Number, Proposed Denomination of the new variety, and Date of Application.

- i. Close-up picture of a single flower (attached to inflorescence; taken against a scale ruler)
- ii. Close-up picture of a single inflorescence (attached to plant; taken against a scale ruler)
- iii. A picture of the whole plant (taken against a standard 30cm ruler)
- iv. Any other picture(s) of the plant or part(s) of plant that will distinguish the variety from other varieties.
