Circular No. 2/2018: Concierge services

Concierge services

(Circular No. 2/2018, dated 27 July 2018)

The Registry wishes to update the public with regard to the change in classification practice for “concierge services” in an application for the registration of a trade mark.

Currently, the description “concierge services” per se, without further qualification, is considered vague and hence unacceptable as a specification description.

With the addition of the description “concierge services” into Class 45 of the Eleventh Edition, Version 2019 of the Nice Classification (hereinafter abbreviated as “NCL (11-2019)”), the Registry will accept “concierge services” per se in Class 45 for applications lodged on or after 1 January 2019.

This circular supersedes Circular No. 6/2009, dated 30 April 2009 on “Concierge services”, which will be removed upon the entry into force of NCL (11-2019).
